## From the Pastor's Desk

### Easter Invitation

**“He is not here; he has risen, just as he said.”** (Matthew 28:6. NIV)

Easter is a celebration of Christ's resurrection from the dead! It is the crucible of our faith and the crux of everything else we believe and practice about Christianity. The famous Chicago pastor and evangelist of the 19th century, D.L. Moody said, **“The resurrection is the keystone of the arch on which our faith is supported. If Christ has not risen, we must impeach all those witnesses for lying. If Christ has not risen, we have no proof that the crucifixion of Jesus differed from that of the two thieves who suffered with him. If Christ has not risen, it is impossible to believe his atoning death was accepted.”**

A 2009 Rasmussen report suggested that belief in the resurrection remains firmly planted in people's consciousness in our country: “79% believe the central claim of the Christian faith—that Jesus Christ rose from the dead. Only 10% say they do not believe the first Easter resurrection really happened, while 11% are not sure.” Rasmussen goes on to say, “Overall, women tend to be stronger believers in Jesus Christ than men. 87% of women and 70% of men believe Jesus rose from the dead; 89% of women and 74% of men think he was the son of God.” Religious affiliation has a significant impact on your resurrec-

tion beliefs in that evangelical Christians have the firmest resolve that Jesus rose from the dead (97%) followed by Protestants at 90% and Catholics at 87%.

It's encouraging in our postmodern world, as we approach this Easter holiday and celebrate Christ's victory over sin and death, that many people hold to the belief of Christ's resurrection. A recent report suggests that rapid changes are taking place in the perceived value of belonging to a “religious” group or the Church. The report attempts to provide some understanding for the rapid decline of organized religion in many regions of the world, especially in Western Europe (FoxNews.com. **Study Finds Religion May Be Heading for Extinction in Parts of World.** Downloaded March 23, 2011.). The comparison of these two articles seems to suggest that there remains a strong belief in Christ and His resurrection, yet a detachment from the very Church Christ empowered to carry on His work.

In some ways it reminds me of one of the stories recorded in Luke's gospel as Jesus headed down the road to Jerusalem and the cross that awaited Him. There on the road along the border of Samaria and Galilee, ten lepers cried out to him asking for His mercy. Jesus healed them all but only one leper returned to give praise (See Luke 17:15).

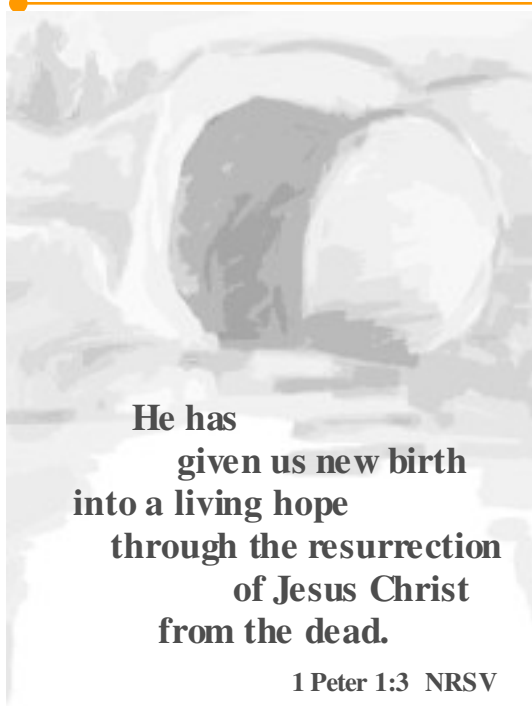
