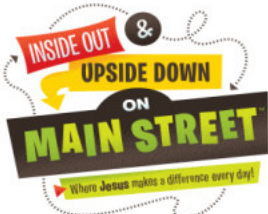

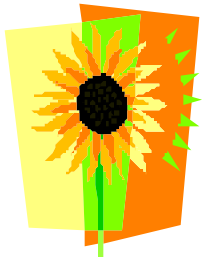


30-days of Prayer for the Muslim World August 1-30, 2011

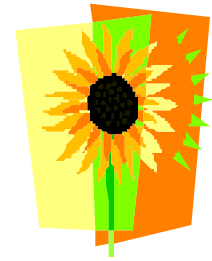
The 30-days Prayer Focus on the Muslim world (coinciding annually with the Muslim month of Ramadan) call Christians worldwide to make a deliberate effort to learn about, pray for and reach out to Muslim neighbors...across the street and around the world. Now more than ever...In today's climate of terrorism in the name of Islam and upheavals in the Arab world, this prayer focus (and the accompanying prayer guide booklets) has proven to be an effective tool to help Christians respond more prayerfully and Christ-like. Let's be informed, and pray with faith, hope and love! During this month of fasting, when many Muslims are more open to spiritual things, many have been converted to Christianity through visions and dreams from God. We can trust God to break through even the hardest hearts and closed minds!

The 2011 edition of the booklet contains daily readings that focus on a variety of topics, including people groups and geographical areas of the Muslim world, followed by prayer points. It also features informative background articles on Islam culture and religion with resources for further study and involvement. We have several copies of the prayer guide booklet available to those who would commit to pray for the designated 30 days. There is also a kids' version that would be appropriate for families to use together. Just ask for either one in the church office free of charge.

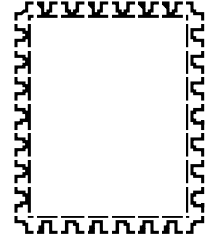
