



## From the Pastor's Desk

### We're Still Here!

Harold Camping, head of the Christian ministry Family Radio International, recently made quite a stir in our country and parts of the world by predicting that the world would come to an end on May 21, 2011. Camping is an 89-year-old former civil engineer who, in 1961, started an open forum radio ministry which now has over \$100 million in assets. His prophecy calling for the return of Christ just this last Saturday was picked up by the mainstream media and captured the attention of millions of people in North America and the world. I know many Christians dismissed the foolishness of his prediction recognizing Mr. Camping as a false prophet for a similar prediction that failed to come to pass in 1994. The irony is that the only scripture that Camping fulfilled was that in the last days... "Many false prophets will appear and deceive many people." It is, however, somewhat astonishing how many people in the secular world had obviously inwardly deliberated about Camping's apocalyptic deception. It was the subject of discussion among many school children and adults at work places. Many people who were not followers of Camping were concerned and at least somewhat worried about the end of the world.

My daughter told me that at school some of the children were talking about Camping's prediction with maybe a tinge of concern, when one young male student spoke up, quoting from Matt. 24:36, that

"No one knows about that day or hour, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father." Good for this young man! While even many adults lived in some fear, this young man knew where to turn for answers: THE BIBLE. This student had enough confidence in God's Word so that when a false prophet made a foolish prediction, he trusted not in a deceiving adult who led many astray, but in the Word of God that he had hidden in his heart.

I am certain that this young man has had conversations with adults like his parents or leaders in his church who were teaching him the Word of God. He may have learned that in Sunday school or youth group, or even around the dinner table talking with his mother and father. But it reminds us that with the deceptions of our times, biblical teaching is important, because when others may be confused or even deceived, we have God's Living Word.

Scripture has one final word for Harold Camping and men like him found in Deuteronomy chapter 18, verses 21-22: "You may say to yourselves, 'How can we know when a message has not been spoken by the LORD?' If what a prophet proclaims in the name of the LORD does not take place or come true, that is a message the LORD has not spoken. That prophet has spoken presumptuously. 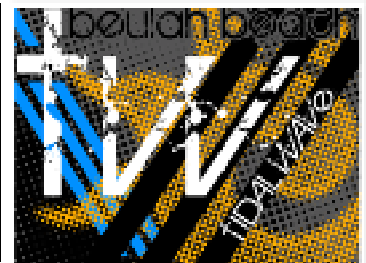

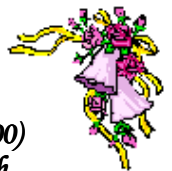

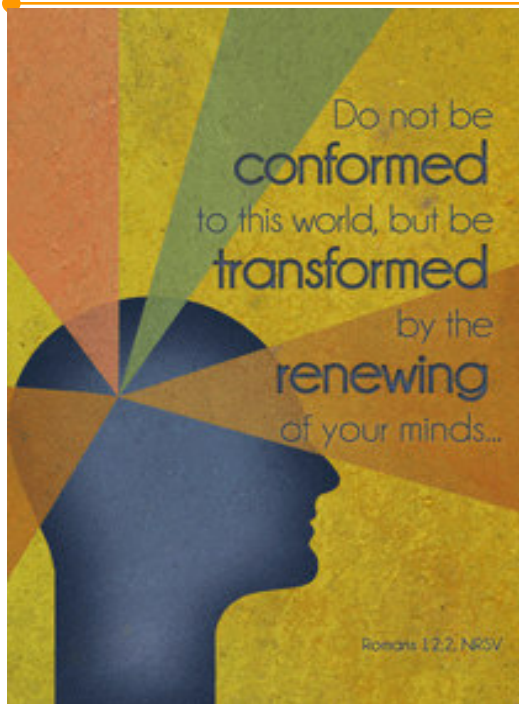
