Back to School...Back to Church!

By now parents have sent their children back to school and home school parents have begun again the task of educating their children after a little summer vacation. One way to enhance your children academically might surprise many parents: that is making sure your children attend church.

may contribute to higher expectations of families and the extra effort of students from these homes.

Whatever the reason, it is a good reminder to your families, grandchildren, loved ones and students that attending church can impact both the mind and soul. It also presents an opportunity to urge you to join us for our youth activities for junior and senior high students on Sundays and Wednesday evenings and for King's Kids for preschool and elementary age students on Wednesday evenings. Don't forget Sunday school classes for all ages on Sunday mornings at 9:30 a.m. and children's church for preschoolers and elementary age kids midway through the 2nd worship service. We hope you will come and bring your children on Sundays and/or for mid-week events. After all, it may even help your child's academic performance!

According to Jennifer Glanville, a sociologist in the University of Iowa College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, students who attend church have higher GPA's and they are more likely to value education and less likely to drop out of school. Teens have a 60% greater probability of dropping out of school if they do not attend weekly church services or youth activities. Grade point averages for church attending students are an average of .114 higher than non-attending students. Reasons for this anomaly are more speculative than certain, suggesting better role models, more positive peer interaction, as well as healthier social structures in their lives. Missing in the article published in the 2008 winter issue of The Sociological Quarterly was any discussion on the world view of Christians and the Judeo-Christian values which

God's redemptive plan is to shine His light into the hearts and lives of those trapped in spiritual darkness. He chose us to illuminate this world and His instructions are clear: "For you were once darkness, but now **you are light in the Lord**. Live as children of light" (Ephesians 5:8). The 2011 Missions Conference theme—*Points of Light*—reminds us of our sacred trust to be the bearers of His light, here and abroad!

We will be hearing from two of our official C&MA international "light-bearers" to the predominantly Muslim nation of Indonesia. Some of our team members met with John Howard, C&MA missionary in Guadalajara, Mexico and our translator for our last couple of trips to San José, when he was here this summer. Several factors prevent us from doing a dental mission this year so we threw around some ideas for ministry both in San José and in **La Ventosa Juchitán, Oaxaca**, where **Ruben Luna**, one of our Mexican partners, pastors a C&MA church. It would be helpful to foster our relationship with Pastor Ruben and perhaps encourage him and his church to adopt the Mazatecos and make some evangelistic trips to San José on their own, with some financial help from us, which would be a more efficient use of funds. We still do not have a **translator** lined up, so that is also a matter for your prayers. Please pray with us that God would show us how best to use our resources to reach the Mazatecos and what our next ministry trip (originally scheduled for Nov. 1-9) should accomplish. Our team includes **Rick & Andrea Jones, Cheri Madden, Lynne Thomas, & Pastor Andy.**

The Ramey Report Face of My Father Children's Home in San Marcos, Mexico

The Rameys are returning to Zanesville at the end of this month, ending their ministry at the Children's Home. The Cookes will continue caring for the 10 children in the home until a replacement couple is found.

Tod & Kristi and the girls will have a great many needs as they travel back to the States and set up housekeeping here again. If you would like to help with some of those practical & financial aspects, please don't hesitate to call the office to see what specific needs they have.

Please PRAY for the family as they prepare to turn the houseparenting duties over to the Cookes, pack personal belongings and travel through Mexico, cross the border, then begin their lives again here. 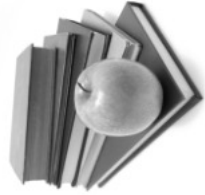

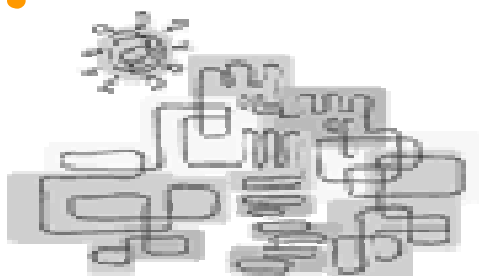
